

Died.

Mrs. David Graham, of Addie, who had been at St. John's hospital, Fargo, for seven weeks undergoing treatment for cancer, died last Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. The remains were brought to Hannaford where the funeral was held on Friday from the Presbyterian church, the Rev. H. Styles Harriss of the Cooperstown Methodist church preaching the sermon, and interment was made in the Hannaford cemetery beside her son who died a year ago last August.
