

New Fire Engine.

City Council Makes Provision For New Fire Engine.

At an adjourned meeting of the city council held on Monday evening of this week a new fire engine was purchased from the Waterous Engine Co. of St. Paul. The new fire fighter is a 40-horse power gasoline engine, one of the latest models of its kind, and will be a valuable acquisition to the fire department of the city. The new engine is guaranteed to throw a stream of water through 1000 feet of hose from 130 to 140 feet, two streams through 500 feet of hose 125 feet, three streams through 3 1/2 feet of hose from 90 to 100 feet. The city will now be equipped with both a steamer and gasoline engine and will be in better shape than ever to fight fire. The new engine can be started and water thrown through hose in from one to two minutes.
