

PROCEEDINGS

of the Board of County Commissioners of Griggs County, North Dakota.

The Board convened pursuant to adjournment Nov. 21st, 1910. Present, Commissioners Blackwell, Buchelt, Nelson and Huso. Nicolai Swenson and R. H. Larson, supervisors of Bartley township, appeared before the Board in regard to the grade between sections 9 and 16 of that township. On Feb. 15, 1910, a petition was presented praying for aid in constructing the grade and an appropriation of \$350 was made at that time as a partial payment on the work. The supervisors having shown that the grade is completed and that an additional amount of \$550 is required to pay the cost of the grade and culverts, a motion was made, seconded and carried, granting an appropriation of \$550 to Bartley township to be used for the purpose stated.

A motion was made, seconded and carried ordering that \$196.93 be transferred from the County Road Fund to the Bartley Drain Fund. This is the amount of benefits assessed against the school lands, Sec. 16-144-60, and which was assumed by the county on account of the benefit to the township roads derived from the construction of the drain.

A motion was made, seconded and carried ordering that all the 1910 primary election filing fees be refunded.

Commissioner Blackwell reported the sale of old bridge material for \$91.75. The sale was on motion approved and the proceeds were turned into the treasury.

On motion, an appropriation of \$200 was made to Greenfield township as aid in constructing the road grade between sections 6 and 7 in that township.
