

# PROCEEDINGS

## of the Griggs County Commissioners.

Board convened as per adjournment this 2d day of May, 1910. All members present.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved upon motion.

A petition signed by Emil Johnson and others of Addie township and Boyd Knapp and others of Bryan township asking for an appropriation for grading between Section 36 of Bryan township and Section 31 of Addie township, was on motion granted and the county auditor instructed to advertise for bids to be received at next meeting.

A petition signed by Ole Mickels and others of Lenora township asking for \$500 for purpose of grading a bighough on section line between Sections 3 and 34 in Romness and Lenora townships was presented. Moved seconded and carried that the sum of \$200 be granted and county pay for culvert.

A petition signed by Charley A. Steinborn and others of Helena township was presented asking for a grade between Sections 1 and 2. On motion made, seconded and carried said petition was rejected.

A petition from Bryan township signed by Olaf Johnson and others for a grant of \$500 for grading road between Sections 15 and 22 and 21 and 22, township 147 range 61, was on motion granted at \$300.

A petition signed by J. D. Barclay and others asking for the sum of \$500 for grade between Section 35 in Rosendal township and Section 2 Bryan township and Section 36 in Rosendal township and Section 1 in Bryan township was on motion laid over and the county surveyor instructed to investigate further.

A petition from the Township of Helena signed by Tonnes Boe and others praying for a steel bridge over Bald Hill Creek between Section 24 in Helena township and Section 19 in Ball Hill township was on motion laid on the table.

A petition from Helena township signed by John Hanson and others praying for a steel bridge across run between Sections 20 and 21, said bridge to be 24 foot span and 13 foot above water line and 18 feet wide, was on motion granted, and county

auditor instructed to advertise for bids to be received at next meeting.

A petition from Helena township signed by George Paintner and others for a bridge between Sections 5 and 8 was presented. Motion made, seconded and carried authorizing the construction of a concrete and plank bridge.

On motion made, seconded and carried the county auditor was instructed to advertise for bids for the building of three steel bridges as follows:

Pilot Mound Township between Sections 12 and 13.

Romness Township between Sections 21 and 22, and between Section 36 in Romness township and Section 1 in Washburn township. Bids to be received at next meeting.

The following bids were received for two forty-eight inch diameter metal culverts, 22 feet long, to be delivered at Binford, as advertised:

Greenland & Lunde, Cooperstown, N. D., two 48in galvanized, corrugated metal culverts 22 feet long, 14, gauge weighing 51.04 per foot, \$5.20 per lineal foot laid down at Binford,

Erick Erick Erickson, Cooperstown, N. D., two 48in culverts, 22 feet long, laid down at Binford, \$4.00 per foot.

North Dakota Metal Culvert Company, Fargo, N. D., two 48in diameter, galvanized corrugated culvert pipes, each 22 feet long, 12 gauge metal, delivered at Binford, for \$213.45.

N. O. Haugen, Jessie, N. D., two 48in culvert, 22 feet long, 14 gauge material, \$200 F. O. B, Binford.

On motion, made, seconded and carried, the bid of North Dakota Metal Culvert Company, Fargo, N. D., for \$213.45 was accepted.
