

The Griggs County Telephone company have just installed and put into operation a "Phantom Circuit" for the purpose of giving another rural line at Jessie exchange connection and direct night service to the Cooperstown exchange. The "Phantom Circuit" is one of the newer telephone inventions and has been in practical use but a few years, and is used almost exclusively on Toll lines. The advantage of the "Phantom Circuit" is the gaining of an additional circuit without the need of extra wire. This is accomplished by installing two of these special repeating coils at each end of two physical metallic circuits, and when properly connected makes an extra line of the highest efficiency.
