

PROCEEDINGS

OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF GRIGGS COUNTY, N. D.

The Board did not convene on July 3rd and the session was adjourned until July 5th.

The Board convened in regular session July 5th, 1911, with all the members present.

The minutes of the preceding session were read and approved.

Sander Sanderson and Alex Saunders appeared before the Board with a petition signed by 24 residents of Sverdrup and Broadview townships asking for the construction of a bridge across the Sheyenne river between sections 24 and 25—township 145 range 58. The petition was, on motion, granted, provided that the bridge shall be built early in the season of 1912.

The Co. Supt. of Highways having made a report of road grading done by Gust Arneson between Sec. 1 Twp. 146 Rg. 58 and Sec. 36 Twp. 147 Rg. 58, amounting in cost to \$99.00 and which has been paid by Auditor's warrant No. 3624, the report and payment were, on motion, approved by the Board.

The Co. Supt. of Highways having made a report of the road grading done by John Ness between sections 12 and 13 Twp. 148 Rg. 59 and sections 7 and 8 Twp. 148 Rg. 58, the cost of which amounted to \$321.87, and the same having been paid by Auditor's warrant No. 3645, the report and payment were, on motion, approved by the Board.

A petition was received signed by J. D. Barclay and 5 other residents of Rosendal Twp. asking for aid to the amount of \$300, in constructing a road near the quarter line, north and south, through sections 25 and 26, township 148 range 51. The petition was, on motion, granted, provided that payment shall be made after the Auditor is satisfied that the township has secured the right of way for such proposed road.
