The Board convened in regular session Oct. 2nd, 1911, with Chairman Blackwell and Commissioners Buchelt and Husa present. The minutes of the preceding session were read and approved.

On motion, it was ordered that the county treasurer be allowed a deputy or clerk at an expense of not to exceed \$300.00 a year.

The county surveyor having made a report of grading at the approaches to the new bridge in Broadview township, amounting to \$101.00 and the same having been paid to John Loge by auditor's warrant No. 3677, the report and payment were, on motion, approved by the Board.

The quarterly report of the states attorney was filed and was, on motion, approved by the Board.
