JUNE 8th, 1906,

At the Cooperstown Fair Grounds

FORENOON.

9:30—Grand Parade.

10:30—Base Ball; Purse \$30.00; money goes to the winning team.

NOON.

Ox will commence to disappear as well as the Free Coffee and Lemonade.

AFTERNOON.

1:00—Several ten-minute speeches by the Old Settlers.

2:00—RACES.

\$40.00 for 2:20 Trot or Pace $\frac{1}{2}$ of a mile, best 2 in 3; 3 to start; no division of money.

\$25.00 running race, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile dash, free for all.

\$10.00 running race, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile dash, free for ponies under 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ hands.

\$10.00 for the best appearing double team hitched to carriage, driven by a lady.

\$5.00 for the best appearing single horse and buggy driven by a lady.

\$30.00 for a team of oxen or a mule and ox in harness, the best representation of the period from 1880 to 1885; divided \$15, \$10 and \$5.

There will be a lot of old fashioned games during the day; but the most interesting feature of the program is to be an old fashioned game of base ball played by old settlers.
