

Mr. and Mrs. Nels Arneson, living on the old Mardell farm, last week lost two of their little children, Beatrice, 4 years old, and Robert 1 year old. Beatrice died late Tuesday night from malignant scarlet fever, and was buried Wednesday afternoon. Robert died early Friday morning from Toxæmia from the throat, lungs and bowels and was buried in the afternoon. Rev. J. M. Jensen officiated at both funerals, these being private, it was deemed best to have them so by Dr. Almklov who had the cases in charge. Mr. and Mrs. Arneson are deeply in sorrow on account of their loss, a loss that can only be fully realized by suffering parents. Through sympathizing hearts alone the sorrow with these bereaved ones can be only partially relieved, because human sympathy is so limited to cope with such experiences when they come so entirely unexpected, but in the hour of trial and gloom it should be a comfort to know that the Good Shepherd says: "Suffer the little children to come unto me and forbid them not for of such is the kingdom of God."
