

Richard Brosten died at his farm home south of this city last Friday after an illness of only two days. He was stricken with appendicitis and Dr. Platou was called up from Valley City. It was decided to take him to the hospital at Valley City on Saturday but he died suddenly the day previous. The deceased was one of the early settlers of the county, coming here in the early eighties and taking up land. He was a married man and leaves a wife and several children.
