Tornado Has Fatal Results

In Severe Windstorm Early Sunday Morning
Halvor Ormson was Struck by Flying
Timber and Instantly Killed.

In the severe windstorm that visited this section early Sunday morning considerable damage was done on the Ole Hagen farm a few miles southwest of here and caused the death of Mr. Hagen's father-in-law, Halvor Ormson, a widower about 80 years old.

Mr. Ormson was sleeping in the granary and the wind in its fury picked this building up and hurled it several rods. It seems that Mr. Ormson was struck by a flying timber, crushing his head and killing him instantly.
