

MRS. JOS. EBENTIRE DEAD



One of the Oldest Settlers of Griggs County Passed Away Last Wednesday Afternoon.



Mrs. Joseph Ebentire died at 2:30 p. m., last Wednesday afternoon in St. John's hospital, Fargo. The deceased had been in poor health for the past two years and for the past few months has been taking treatment at a sanatorium in Fargo and only a few days before her death she commenced to fall rapidly and was taken to St. John's hospital where everything possible was done to prolong life but to no avail and she passed to that bourne from which no traveller returns.
