

## Death of Mrs. Mason Knapp.

Mrs. Mason Knapp, of this city, died at her home last Saturday afternoon after being practically bed ridden for the past two years and an invalid for the past eight years. Paralysis was the cause of death, the deceased becoming afflicted at the birth of her little daughter eight years ago. Mrs. Knapp's maiden name was Mamie J. Remington and she was born in Kincardine, Ontario, Canada, Feb. 21, 1871. She moved to North Dakota with her parents when twelve years old and was married to Mason Knapp November 1, 1893. From that union two children have been born and are now living, a boy about thirteen and a little girl eight who are now left to struggle through life without the guiding hand of a mother. The funeral was held Monday afternoon, Rev. J. G. Dwyer officiating, the remains being laid to rest in the M. Hartman Memorial church cemetery in Mabel township west of town. The stricken family have the sympathy of friends in this hour of bereavement.
