

Mike Leoleoh, an austrian working on the G. N. construction train at Hannaford, was killed last Saturday. He gave the signal to slow up, which was obeyed by the engineer, and then when getting off his trousers caught on a projection of the car, throwing him forward on the track directly in its path. A fellow workman saw the mishap and gave the signal to stop which was done, but too late to prevent the car from running over the poor fellow. His head and one arm was crushed, death resulting instantaneously. Deceased was 20 years of age and single, his only relative in this country being a brother who worked in the same crew. The remains were interred at Hannaford. Dr. Almklov was called and pronounced it accidental death.
