The following obituary from the J Iola, Kansas Daily Register, will be of interest to the many friends of S the McDaniel family in this county: D. D. McDaniel was born in Davis county, Iowa, in 1854, and moved to Illinois with his parents when eight years of age. In 1876 he came to Colony, Kansas, in which city on March 30th, 1881, he was married to Miss Mirtie Whitaker, of near Carlyle. Of this union one child was born on April 20th, 1882. Within the lapse of a little more than a year both mother and child died and were laid to rest in Iola cemetery. Shortı ly afterwards Mr. McDaniel returned to Illinois where he remained slightly more than a year, and then went to North Dakota, where he farmed for sixteen years. In 1888 while on a visit to his father and mother be 1confessed his faith in Christ and became united with the Christian t church, continuing as a member up to the time of his death. In 1889 he ıf met and married Miss Mable Dine in North Dakota. In 1900 they moved to 8 Illinoiis. In 1905 they traveled by wagon through Missouri, Kansas, Oklahoma, Southeastern Colorado, New Mexico and Texas, for the benefit of Mr. McDaniels' health. As his r condition, after three years of travd el, did not seem to improve, he decided to return to Iola. He died on ıt February 8th, 1911, his age being nfifty-six years, eight months and is twenty-one days. He is survived by fa wife, two brothers, two sisters and ю many other relatives and friends. n-
