

W. H. PHIPPS DEAD.

B. C. Phipps received a telegram last Friday morning conveying the news of the death of his father, W. H. Phipps, which occurred at Los Angeles, California, on Thursday of last week, October 5. Particulars of the illness of Mr. Phipps had not been received. The deceased was for several years a prominent and much esteemed business man of this city, being the original owner of the Cooperstown flour mill. He and his family were well liked here and the many friends of the bereaved family will regret exceedingly to hear of his demise. He leaves besides a widow, several children, B. C. Phipps, of McHenry; Ray Phipps, who is out in California, and Mrs. Drinkwater, of Bowbells, this state. Until recently Mr. Phipps was a member of the local Masonic lodge, withdrawing to affiliate with a lodge in California. B. C. Phipps on receipt of the message immediately wired his mother to have the remains shipped to Paynesville, Minn., their old home, for interment, which will probably be done.
