

Died.

Mrs. Rozina Adams, who has made her home here with her sons, Charley, George and William, died last Saturday morning, July 22, 1905, at St. John's hospital, Fargo, where she had been taken a week previous to undergo an operation for gall stones.

The remains were brought to Cooperstown and the funeral took place Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Baptist church. Rev. S. Batchelor officiating, and burial was made in the Cooperstown cemetery.

Rozina Ecker was born Oct. 22, 1840, near Royal Oak, Michigan; was married to George Adams in 1860. To them were born the three sons named above. In 1874 the family moved from Michigan to Wyoming Valley, Wisconsin, where the husband died in 1874. In 1883 Mrs. Adams and sons moved to Faulk Co., South Dakota, came to Ludden, this state, in 1891, and to Griggs Co. in Dec., 1898, where they have since resided. Mrs. Adams was a Christian woman and was a member of a Union church. She was a member of the Rebekah lodge, under whose auspices the funeral was held.
