

Died at the Hospital.

Miss Hilma Hallberg, who was taken to Valley City last week to undergo an operation for appendicitis, and whose serious condition was mentioned in last week's issue of the Sentinel, died Friday evening and was taken to her home near Atwater, Minnesota, for burial.
