Last Thursday evening news was received that the body of Martin Knapp had been found at Stump Lake. A few men went up there at once and placed the remains in a coffin and brought them home Friday afternoon. Rev. Dybvig officiated. A large concourse of people followed the remains to the cemetery where the last sad rites were performed. Among the things found on his body was his watch, glass case, pocket book containing some papers and currency also seven or eight silver dollars.
