

—A well-to-do farmer by the name of Larson, who lived in southwestern Steele county, near Griggs county line, committed suicide last Sunday evening by shooting himself. His wife died a couple years ago and since that time he had gradually grown weak-minded. Sunday his daughter had gone to church and when she returned with a friend they heard a shot, but evidently did not consider it had anything to do with her father. The father was not at home, but apparently nothing was thought of this until the next morning when he was found dead back of the granary with a weapon in one hand and a stick in the other. It was a clear case of suicide. The funeral took place Tuesday from the home, The Rev. Voldal of Cooperstown officiating, and burial was made in the Hope cemetery.
