

Pioneer Dead.

Mrs. Omund Nelson Opheim, mother of Nels Opheim of Washburn township, died at the family home Tuesday evening of this week, Dec. 26, 1905, of old age.

Mrs. Opheim was about 80 years of age. She came here with her husband and children in 1878 or '79, the family being, according to the information obtained from their neighbors, the very first white people to settle in the territory now included in Griggs county. Mr. Opheim, who was known as "Pioneer Nelson," died several years ago.

Mrs. Opheim is survived by the son above mentioned and one daughter, Mrs. Gustaf Olson, now of Jamestown. Further particulars were not obtainable in time for this issue.
