

## Death of a Pioneer.

Mr. John E. Sutton, of 2nd District, writes us enclosing a clipping from the Jackson (Michigan) Patriot, relating the death of a former Griggs county pioneer, Charles C. Robison.

Mr. Robison and Mr. Sutton came to Griggs county in 1884 together and took up adjoining claims and batched together for five years. Mr. Robison's health failed and he sold his farm to Mr. Sutton. He then returned to his old home in Michigan where he resided until his death.

Strange to say, the clipping mentions, an uncle of Charles C. Robison after whom he was named, died on the same date only a couple hours apart, the funerals were held on the same day at the same hour and so close together that those who attended mingled each crowd with the other.
