

## Pioneer Dead.

August Steinborn, one of the pioneers of this county, died at his home in Helena township last Friday at about noon, from apoplexy, aged fifty-eight years. Mr. Steinborn had been in town only a day or two before in his usual health, and on Friday morning had attended to his usual duties about the farm yard and gone out in the field to work, when he was stricken down and had to be taken to the house where he soon succumbed.

August Steinborn was a native of Germany and came to this country with his family in 1881, and located in Griggs county in 1883. As a citizen he was industrious and thrifty and had accumulated a goodly quantity of this world's goods. He leaves his wife and four sons and three daughters to mourn his loss.

The funeral took place on Sunday afternoon from the Lutheran church in Cooperstown, Student Dorkop, of Valley City, officiating, and burial was made in the Cooperstown cemetery.
