

## Republican Caucus.

Hope, N. D., July 22nd, 1892.

The Republican Caucus met at the school house, Friday afternoon, as per call. Called to order at 4-30 p. m. J. P. McMahon was elected chairman and J. M. Stewart was elected secretary.

The chairman stated the object of the caucus, *i. e.*, to elect delegates to Republican Convention to be held at Sherbrooke, on Monday July 25th, to nominate county officers.

On motion, Resolved, that the delegates be elected one at a time and by ballot. 1st ballot informal, J. J. Wamberg 11, J. D. Brown 6, H. H. Baker 5, C. R. Jackson 4, A. Warner 1, G. H. Iseminger 1, B. F. Walden 1, H. H. Wasem 1.

1st formal ballot, J. J. Wamberg 13, J. D. Brown 8, C. R. Jackson 6, B. F. Walden 1, H. H. Baker 2. 2nd formal ballot, J. J. Wamberg 18, C. R. Jackson 6, J. D. Brown 5, H. H. Baker 1. J. J. Wamberg declared elected.

2nd Delegate, informal ballot, J. D. Brown 11, A. Warner 8, C. R. Jackson 6, B. F. Walden 2, H. H. Baker 2. 1st formal ballot, J. D. Brown 18, C. R. Jackson 7, A. Warner 3, B. F. Walden 1. Mr. Brown was elected.

Moved and Resolved, that we reconsider our original motion and Resolved, that the balance of delegates be elected on open motion.

On motion Resolved, that A. Warner and C. R. Jackson be the other two delegates—on rising votes were declared elected.

Motion that this caucus elect 3 central committee men to co-operate with the central committee of the county, carried.
