

Proceedings of the Board of Trustees.

At the regular meeting held April 13, 1891 H. H. Wasem, J. P. McMahon, Jas. Loney, Dan'l Nelson and A. S. Moote were present.

On motion the clerk was instructed to post notices of the election of town officers to be held May 4, 1891.

Moved and carried that the town treasurer be allowed a commission of two (2) per cent. on all town money received by him from the county treasurer.

On motion the following bills were allowed:

L. N. Wood for two per cent. commission on \$102.57, money received for the town from county treasurer, - \$ 2 05

L. E. Marsh for services as clerk of town meeting held April 26, 1890, and for services as clerk of town election held May 17, 1890, 4 00

A. S. Moote for one ladder for lighting street lamps, 1 00

Geo. McLean for one months services lighting street lamps, 4 00

Moved and carried that the salaries of the members of the board of trustees of the town of Hope be fixed at ten (10) dollars per annum for each member.

On motion T. E. Norgord was appointed fire-warden of the town of Hope to fill vacancy caused by the resignation of F. C. Elwell.

Moved and carried that the president of the board instruct the town marshal to see that the citizens of Hope comply with town ordinance No. 1, relating to the cleaning of lots, blocks, etc.

Moved and carried that the annual town election to be held May 4, 1891, be held in Arcade Hall.

On motion the meeting adjourned till April 27, 1891.
