

Proceedings of the Board of Trustees.

Meeting of June 30th called to order by Pres. Wasem, at 9:35 p. m.

Present: Messrs. Wasem, McMahon, Loney, Nelson, Moote.

Minutes of the meeting of June 23d read and approved.

Committee on books presented justice's dockets, treasurer's book, order book, and record book, and on motion they were accepted.

Committee on town dumping ground reported and recommended a site north of town boundary line and near railroad grade. Committee was continued for purpose of completing arrangements.

On motion resignation of J. W. Plunkett as justice of the peace was accepted.

On motion J. D. Brown was appointed justice of the peace, to fill vacancy caused by J. W. Plunkett's resignation.

On motion bills of L. A. Jacobson were allowed and ordered paid, as follows:

For money advanced to Walter Swenson in payment for one day's work surveying town site, \$1 50

For money advanced to Geo. Fesler in payment for one day's work surveying town site, 1 50

Total, \$3 00

On motion an assessment was levied of four mills on the dollar on the assessable property of Hope, at a valuation by assessor's roll of \$73,527.40.

On motion meeting adjourned till July 7th, 1890.
