

## **Proceedings of the Board of Trustees:**

At a special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the town of Hope, N. D., held in the office of E. J. & J. P. McMahon, on the evening of June 2d, 1890, the following were in attendance:

Trustee 1st district, H. H. Wasem.

Trustee 2d district, J. P. McMahon.

Trustee 3d district, J. Loney.

Trustee 4th district, D. Nelson.

Clerk, L. E. Marsh.

On motion the bond of Arthur McLaughlin, marshal, was accepted.

F. C. Elwell was elected, by acclamation, fire-warden of the town of Hope for the ensuing year.

On motion the following specified ordinances for the town government were adopted:

Ordinance No. 1. An ordinance to prevent the improper use of streets, sidewalks, lanes and alleys, and to provide for the cleaning of all streets, alleys, lots and blocks in the town of Hope, N. D., and to provide for keeping them clean; and for the punishment of persons committing or maintaining nuisances.

Ordinance No. 2. An ordinance to prevent cattle, horses, mules or swine from running at large within the town of Hope.

Ordinance No. 3. An ordinance for the protection of shade and ornamental trees, hedges and shrubbery within the town of Hope.

On motion J. P. McMahon was appointed to confer with the editor of the HOPE PIONEER and obtain his rates for publishing the above ordinances.

On motion the meeting was adjourned until the evening of June 9, 1890, at 8 o'clock.
