

Proceedings of the Board of Trustees.

The new board of trustees of the town of Hope met in the office of C. J. Paul on Monday evening, May 11th, 1891, and proceeded with the work of organizing.

Moved and carried that C. J. Paul act as temporary chairman.

Moved and carried that C. J. Paul be elected President of the town board.

The official oaths of the trustees were presented and approved.

Moved that the bond of the Clerk be \$100; Assessor, \$500; Marshall, \$500; Treasurer, \$500, and Justice of the Peace, \$500; carried.

The bonds of L. A. Jacobson, J. M. Stewart and C. G. Merriell were presented and approved.

Moved that L. A. Jacobson be elected as fire warden; carried.

Motion made that the lighting of street lamps be suspended until ordered otherwise by the board of trustees; carried.

Moved and ordered that the regular meetings of the board of trustees of the town of Hope shall be held on the 2nd Monday of January, April, July and October, and that special meetings shall be called by the clerk of said board, upon the request of the majority thereof; and in such cases said clerk shall give at least one day's notice of said special meetings to each member of said board. Said meetings to convene at 7 o'clock p. m., and to be held at the office of the clerk.

Moved and ordered that the amount of the general fund for the current year be fixed in the sum of \$200.

Motion carried to adjourn.
