
A Resolution.

The following resolution was adopted by the board of trustees of the town of Hope, at their first meeting, Monday evening, May 11th, 1891:

WHEREAS, The expenditures and disbursements of the Town of Hope for the last year has amounted to \$291.62, and,

WHEREAS, A large amount thereof to-wit: the sum of \$172.08, was appropriated for salaries of Town Trustees and other officials, and,

WHEREAS, The financial condition of the Town demands retrenchment in expenditures, the present tax levy being inadequate to pay the same, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That no salaries be paid any Town official for the ensuing year.
