Committee chosen on introduction, were H. A. Winslow, J. J. Wamberg, A. R. Baker, W. J. Skinner, W. H. M. Phillip, M. B. Cassel, and C. V. Russ.

Moved, that the general committee vote themselves an executive committee, for all arrangements of the halls etc. C. J. Paul was chosen toast master. G. H. Iseminger was appointed to arrange for some singing.
