

## Case of Leprosy.

**Grand Forks Plaindealer:** A case of genuine leprosy has developed near Northwood, in the southwestern part of the county. Nicolai Nelson, a young boy living with Lars Larson is reported to be suffering from the disease, and the physicians pronounce it a genuine case. Dr. Harriman, superintendent of the county board of health, presented the county commissioners yesterday a report of the state board of health on the case, and advised that the commissioners ship the boy back to Norway, where he came from. His mother is a leper, and a patient of a leperous hospital at Thoudhagen. His father is said to be free from the disease. A younger sister exhibits some signs of the disease, but as it is not developed, no action will be taken in her case, but it is probable that the boy will be shipped back to the place where he came from. This action will be taken under the quarantine laws.
