Mr. Michael Nybo, living about seven miles northwest of Hope, was the victim of a fearful accident last Wednesday, whereby he may lose his life. It seems that a high snow-drift had formed over the top of his stable, and a team of oxen belonging to a neighbor had worked their way up the drift and clear to the top of the stable, which was covered with brush and straw. Mr. Nybo was trying to lead them down, when the roof of the stable gave way precipitating both man and oxen into the stable below. Mr. Nybo fell directly on the horn of one of the oxen, the horn penetrating his right breast, breaking a rib, and puncturing clear through the lung. Dr. Phillip was called as soon as possible to attend the wounded man. He is in a very critical condition, and his recovery is quite doubtful.
