

OFFICIAL VOTE OF STEELE COUNTY.

The following is the official vote of Steele County. It will be seen that Johnson received the handsome plurality of 493 votes. The Republican county ticket was all elected with the exception of States Attorney. Bartlett was defeated by about one hundred votes in the district:
