

OBITUARY.

Evelyn Orrilla, wife of Thomas J. Baldwin, died at her home in Willow Lake township, on Wednesday morning, Oct. 28th, at 7 o'clock of pneumonia, after an illness of several weeks, aged 45 years, 2 months and 20 days.

Deceased was born in the town of Barford, in the eastern townships of Canada, and was united in marriage to Thomas J. Baldwin on the 3rd day of May, 1870. Mrs. Baldwin had been an invalid for many years from heart trouble, and during her last illness suffered extremely, but without complaint. Mr. Baldwin settled in this country in the spring of 1883, his wife following him here the next spring, 1884. During their residence here she had not the opportunity of becoming generally acquainted, on account of her poor health, but was of a loving and kind disposition, and beloved by all who knew her. She was not afraid of death, but faced it bravely and calmly, dying in the Christian faith and with a blessed hope of a glorious resurrection. The funeral services are to be conducted by Rev. S. B. Mahaney from the Congregational church this afternoon, at 3 o'clock, and the remains are to be laid away to rest in the Hope cemetery, there to await the summons from on high.
