We are again called upon to announce the death of one of our early settlers. Mrs. Clarissa Dunning died at the residence of her son, Mr. Joseph Gray, in Colgate township, on Saturday, January 19th, at the ripe old age of 88 years. She was born at Newbury, New York, on the Hudson river, where she spent the first fifty years of her life. About 1850 or 1851 she moved from New York to Wisconsin, where she resided till she came to Dakota about six years ago. Mrs. Dunning was the mother of thirteen children, six of whom survive her. A large number of her grand children reside in Dakota. Her last illness was of short duration. It seemed rather the body was

Which the soul had broken and thrown away."

The funeral occurred Tuesday, and was largely attended by friends and neighbors, the remains being buried near the Colgate schoolhouse. The services were conducted by Rev. S. B. Mahaney, of the M. E. church.
