**Proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners.**

Sherbrooke, N. D., August 6th, 1892.

The Board of County Commissioners met at 10 o'clock a. m. pursuant to adjournment, Present: Chairman Pease and Commissioners Curry, Schjeldahl and Williams.

The proceedings of the meetings of July 11th and 14th were read and approved.

The following bills were on motion allowed and ordered paid from the general fund:

The petition of Louis Kern and others for a bridge between sections 21 and 23 Newburgh township, was on motion laid on the table.

The following resolution was on motion adopted: Whereas, this Board has been authorized and requested by the President of the North Dakota Agricultural College, to appoint a student to said college, for the Academic year beginning September 27th, 1892, Therefore, be it resolved that the County Auditor be directed to advertise for applicants for said scholarship, explaining in the advertisement the terms and qualifications for the same.

On motion the Board adjourned until 1-30 o'clock p. m.

Board re-convened at 1-30 o'clock p. m. Present all members.

Moved and ordered that Commissioner Day be appointed a committee of one to purchase material for painting the County Building, and that the County Auditor be directed to employ a painter to do the work.

The report of Mr. Schjeldahl who was appointed to inspect the Newburgh, Enger and Primrose bridges, and Mr. Day who was appointed to inspect the Colgate bridge, were on motion accepted.

On motion the Newburgh, Primrose, Enger and Colgate Bridges, were accepted.

On motion the bill of Wellington VanDusen, for building the Newburgh, Primrose, and Colgate bridges, \$120 00 was allowed and ordered paid from the Bridge fund.

On motion the bill of F. R. Rugg, for building the Enger Bridge \$73 00 was allowed and ordered paid from the Bridge fund.

On motion the County Auditor was instructed to advertise for bids for 25 tons of hard coal, one half of said coal to be delivered at Sherbrooke during the month of October, 1892 balance to be delivered before the 1st of January, 1893. Bids to be opened at 12 o'clock noon, on Monday the 3rd day of October, 1892.
