

Death of An Old Citizen.

Johannes Christianson, a resident of this county for the past twenty-one years, died at his home in Rogers Monday, May 5. Death was not unexpected, as he had been ill for several months. He was laid to rest Wednesday, May 7, in the cemetery at Dazey. Mr. Christianson was born in Norway August 20, 1817. He came to this country in 1854 and settled near Rushford, Minn., and in 1881 moved to Barnes county. In January, 1858, he was married to Miss Bertha Nethland. Three boys were born, one of whom died as a child. The other two are residents and prosperous farmers of this county; C. J. Christianson, formerly a member of the legislature, and Thomas Christianson. In November, 1862, Mr. Christianson's wife died, and in 1865 he was married the second time to Martha Halvorson, who survives him. There were three daughters by the second marriage. All except one daughter were present at the funeral. Rev. Berg officiated at the funeral.
