

### Another Old Settler Gone.

Frederick Wilhelm Schulz, a resident of Noltimier township, passed away on Monday last after a brief illness. The immediate cause of death was heart failure.

Mr. Schulz was born at Rostin, Germany, on March 8, 1824, and came to this country twenty-one years ago, locating on a farm in Noltimier township. In 1844 he was married to Miss Wilhemina Preba, his wife dying in November, 1897. There were seven children, all of whom are residents of this county. The children are Mrs. Caroline King, Mrs. Henrietta Noske, Mrs. Amelia Wittenberg, William Schulz, Fred Schulz, Mrs. Fredericka Schroeder, Mrs. Minnie Galhoff. There are about forty grandchildren. For a good many years Mr. Schulz has made his home with his daughter, Mrs. Wittenberg.

The funeral was held Wednesday afternoon at the German M. E. church in Noltimier township, Rev. E. P. Christ officiating.
