

## CHRIST GILBERTSON DEAD.

Was a Pioneer in Barnes County.

Remains Shipped to Minnesota for Burial.

Tuesday evening, Jan. 10th at 9 o'clock occurred the death of Christ Gilbertson of this place after several weeks illness with pneumonia. Mr. Gilbertson was a blacksmith by trade and was an early settler in Barnes county, having worked at his trade near by and in the town of Dazey for several years before coming to Wimbledon, where he had been successful in business for a number of years and was a law abiding citizen and always ready and willing to aid in any thing for the advancement of the town.

About three weeks ago he was taken sick with pneumonia and everything that medical skill and kind friends could do for him proved of no avail and on the above date he passed away, after much suffering. During the last few days prior to his death he was unconscious. Dr. Platou of Valley City was called last week but recommended no change in the treatment given by Dr. Wanner. Mr. Gilbertson's brother from Minnesota arrived the first of last week and remained until his brother's death. Brief funeral services were held at J. H. Anderson's home Wednesday afternoon, Rev. Laughlin of Dazey presiding. The remains were shipped to Minnesota for burial on the evening train.
