

August Netting Dead.

August Netting, one of the early settlers of this community, died at a hospital in Fargo Tuesday evening. Deceased had been suffering for two months or more with a decayed bone in one of his legs and the attending physicians advised an operation as the only means of his recovery and on Monday he was taken to the hospital at Fargo and the leg was amputated on Tuesday. He died about three hours after the operation.

The remains were brought to Wimbledon Wednesday night and taken to the farm east of town.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow. After a short service at the house, the remains will be escorted to the German Reform Church where the funeral service will be held.

The sympathy of the entire community is extended to the bereaved wife and other relatives.
