

THE VILLAGE SCHOOLS.

The Wimbledon Schools have finished their 2nd week's work of the regular course. With the addition of a teacher to the staff of instruction and the institution of a High School Department in connection with the Grammar School, the efficiency of the school has been greatly increased and desirable results are anticipated. The course in the Grammar School is identical with that prescribed by the State Supt. of Public Instruction; while the High School curriculum offers elective Commercial and Latin courses.
