

A VERY PECULIAR CASE

WOMAN RESIDING NEAR LITCHVILLE DIES BEFORE DOCTORS ARRIVE.

Litchville Bulletin: Mrs. Delbert Cross, living six miles north of town, was taken suddenly ill Saturday night and died before medical aid could be summoned. The suddenness of her death and the obscurity of the cause of death prompted her husband and friends to call for a post mortem examination. The autopsy was performed by Drs. Spicer and Meyers of Marion, who found death to have been due to heart trouble. An old growth of the heart wall within the heart cavity having severed its connection with the wall of the organ became lodged and entangled with the valvular opening leading from the heart, thus stopping the flow of blood and bringing on paralysis of the heart.
