The case of John Kania, as administrator of the estate of Frank Kania, deceased, vs. the Northern Pacific Railway Co., has been transferred from the district court of Stutsman county to the federal court at Fargo. The action is to recover \$72,000 damages on account of the death of Frank Kania who, according to the complaint, was fatally injured in the company's yards at Carrington on Oct 11, 1905, as a result of the alleged carelessness of the engineer in not obeying signals.
