WANDERED AWAY TO HIS DEATH

PARENTS OF HARRY DUNLAP, COME TO NORTH DAKOTA TO PUSH INVESTIGATION.

an investigation into the cause

On Nov. 8 last Dunlap was arrested in Williston for an assault upon Earl Alleman. After being held in jail for a short time he was found to be suffering from delirium tremens and was removed to a hospital. Two days later he left with the intention of going only a short distance, but that was the last seen of him.

Officials were notified and a search started. Traces of him were discovered near Twelvemile hill, where he had broken into two shacks in quest of food. He had also been to the home of a friend named Haas in that district, remaining there several hours.

Mr. and Mrs. William Dunlap, the father and mother, desire to take the body back to Iowa for burial.
