VALLEY CITY MAN IS FOUND DEAD CLOTHING ON THE BANK BODY FOUND IN A FEW OF WATER. Valley City, N. D., July 1.-A party of boys roaming along the river bank just below the rapids discovered the nude body of a man some twenty feet from the bank. They gave the alarm and Deputy Sheriff Heimas and Dr. S A. W. MacDonald went at once to the scene of the tragedy and the body proved to be that of Tom Gunderson, one of the oldest and best known citizens of . Barnes county. The body was r recovered and taken to the undertaking parlors of Marten Somedahl. Mr. Gunderson had not been missed from the office of Platou h and MacDonald, where he kept books, and death is shrowded in r mystery. The body was discov-S ered some 300 or 305 rods down ıl the Rasmussen road from where d the automobile road branches off to go to the fair grounds. At n this point the timber is thick and e the trees quite large. His clothe ing hung on the branch of a tree d in orderly array while the nude n body rested on the bottom, the ıt head and lower end of the trunk V under water but the back pro-S jecting above. The water was n not to exceed two and half feet r deep. e Tom Gunderson was one of d the best known and most poput ular men in Barnes county. 1-He was county auditor for many years and held several positions of trust and honor during his d residence here. e
