

## **DEATH OF EDWARD SCHRADE**

Edward Schrade was born in Adams county Pennsylvania in the year 1872 and died at Jamestown, N. D., May 26 1910 being 37 years old. He came to North Dakota about five years ago and has been a faithful laborer around Courtenay until about New Years of the present year at which time he lost his mind. Since that time he has been in the hospital at Jamestown. Nothing could be done that would give any restoration to his lost powers and at last he succumbed to the direful malady.

Most of his people still live in Pennsylvania and being so far away could not attend the funeral. His brother Harry, alone, was with him here in North Dakota. Three sisters, one brother and his parents still live around the old homestead near Harrisburg and two brothers reside in Maryland. He was a single man and leaves his immediate home relatives to mourn his sad end. We trust his departure has been a healing balm as no doubt he has escaped a world of sorrow. Funeral services were held from the Presbyterian church Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock and burial made in the Courtenay cemetery.
