

An accident occurred Tuesday afternoon which easily might have ended fatally. While engaged in cleaning a 22. rifle, Oscar, a younger son of Julius Hohenhouse who lives north of town, accidentally discharged the gun and the bullet entered the body of his father who was at work in a blacksmith shop near the house. Being in a stooping position at the time of the accident it was impossible for Dr. Shepard, who was hastily summoned, to locate the bullet and it was found necessary to take him to a hospital at Valley City to have an X-ray picture taken in order to locate it. From last reports received, however, no trace of it has been found. The doctors stated that the patient was resting easy and it was deemed advisable to await developments before any further actions were taken.
