He is well pleased with the business outlook of that part of the country, the volume transacted being fairly good for an off year. Besides the state institution, Grafton has a flour mill of 500 barrels capacity per day and Mr. Nelson states that not a bushel of the grain raised in that vicinity is shipped outside of the state. The farmers are realizing more and more the necessity of diversified farming and an up-to-date creamery is greatly aiding the lessening of time between crops of wheat which requires a period of one whole year while the creamery money is derived monthly.
