Hans Nelson received 1400 head of sheep this morning from Gilford, Mont., the shipment coming in five cars. Mr. Nelson took them on his farm today where he will turn them out to feed on his fields recently destroyed by hail. The sheep were in poor condition but the excellent feed to be had on the fields, which have become green after the fine rain, it is expected that they will soon fatten in fine shape. Aside from the fact that n they will double in value after four or five weeks grazing, the land itself will be benefitted immensely by the animals cleaning it of all foul weeds which they readily eat.
