

Tuesday evening Mrs. B. H. Stoddard was taken to a hospital at Minneapolis to have an operation for appendicitis performed. Mrs. Stoddard complained of feeling ill shortly after returning from a meeting of the Ladies Aid society on Wednesday of last week but no serious developments were anticipated until Saturday, when her temperature rose to 101. Dr. Shepard, who was in attendance, then diagnosed the case to be a serious attack of appendicitis and urged the patient to be taken to a hospital where adequate care could be given her, but arrangements were not made until Tuesday.
